Show this card to any doctor or healthcare professional involved in your care.</p> <p>See the voriconazole package leaflet for more information.</p>	<p>You should avoid exposure to sunlight during voriconazole treatment. It is important to cover sun exposed areas of skin and use sunscreen with high sun protection factor (SPF), as an increased sensitivity of skin to the sun's UV rays can occur. There is a small chance that skin cancer could develop over time.</p> <p>You should contact your doctor immediately if you experience: sunburn or severe skin reaction following exposure to light or sun e.g., severe skin rash or blisters.</p>
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
