DiproBath 46% w/w and 39% w/w Bath Additive Light liquid paraffin and Isopropyl myristate

1. WHAT DIPROBATH IS AND WHAT IT IS USED FOR

DiproBath is a bath additive. It helps to soothe and soften the skin. DiproBath leaves a thin film of oil over the skin and helps to prevent the skin drying out. It is used to treat dry skin conditions and conditions where the skin is thickened and scaly, such as in dermatitis and eczema.

Dermatitis is inflammation of the skin.

Eczema is a common skin disease, which causes the skin to become red and itchy.

2. BEFORE YOU USE DIPROBATH

Do not use DIPROBATH

- if you are allergic (hypersensitive) to any of the other ingredients of DiproBath.

3. HOW TO USE DIPROBATH

Always use DiproBath exactly as your doctor has told you. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure.

TAKE CARE ON GETTING IN AND OUT OF THE BATH BECAUSE IT MAY BE MORE SLIPPERY THAN USUAL.

For a full bath (100 litres) add 25ml (approximately 2.5 capfuls) to the bathwater and mix.

For a child's bath (25-30 litres) add 10ml of DiproBath (1 capful).

If your skin is particularly dry the above quantities may be doubled. You should take 2-3 baths a week.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

If you think that you are suffering from any side effects after using DiproBath, you should speak to your doctor or pharmacist.

5. HOW TO STORE DIPROBATH

Do not store above 25°C.

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

Do not use after the date “use by” which is stamped on the pack. This refers to the last date of that month.

6. FURTHER INFORMATION

What DIPROBATH contains

- The active substances are light liquid paraffin 46 % w/w and isopropyl myristate 39 % w/w
- The other ingredient is Laureth-4.

What DIPROBATH looks like and contents of the pack

It is available in either a bottle containing 50 ml or a bottle containing 500 ml. Not all pack sizes may be marketed.
