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**You should avoid exposure to direct sunlight during VORICONAZOLE treatment. It is important to cover sun exposed areas**

of skin and use sunscreen with high sun protection factor (SPF), as an increased sensitivity of skin to the sun's UV rays can occur.

**You should contact your doctor immediately if you experience: sunburn or severe skin reaction, such as rash or blisters, or abnormal skin lesions following exposure to light or sun.**
