1 NAME OF THE MEDICINAL PRODUCT

innohep 10,000 IU in 0.5 ml, solution for injection

2 QUALITATIVE AND QUANTITATIVE COMPOSITION

Tinzaparin sodium 20,000 anti-Factor Xa IU/mL.
Excipients with known effect: Sodium metabisulphite.

6.1 List of excipients

Sodium metabisulfite
Sodium hydroxide (for pH-adjustment)
Water for injections

6.2 Incompatibilities

In the absence of compatibility studies, this medicinal product must not be mixed with other medicinal products.

6.3 Shelf life

The shelf-life expiry date of this product shall be the date shown on the container and outer package of the product on the market in the country of origin.

Any portion of the contents not used at once should be discarded. The liquid may turn yellow in storage but this does not affect product quality.

6.4 Special precautions for storage

Do not store above 25°C.
For storage conditions after first opening of the medicinal product, see section 6.3.

6.5 Nature and contents of container

Glass syringe contains 0.5ml solution with a plastic needle safety device. Supplied in packs of 2 or 10 syringes. Not all pack sizes may be marketed.

6.6 Special precautions for disposal of a used medicinal product or waste materials derived from such medicinal product and other handling of the product

Do not use if cloudiness or particles are visible in the liquid. Any unused medicinal product or waste material should be disposed of in accordance with local requirements.
