

Summary of Product Characteristics

1 NAME OF THE MEDICINAL PRODUCT

Seretide 500 Diskus 50 microgram/500 microgram/dose inhalation powder, pre-dispensed

2 QUALITATIVE AND QUANTITATIVE COMPOSITION

Each single dose of Seretide provides:

50 micrograms of salmeterol (as salmeterol xinafoate) and 500 micrograms of fluticasone propionate.

Excipients: lactose monohydrate.

For a full list of excipients, see section 6.1.

3 PHARMACEUTICAL FORM

Inhalation powder, pre-dispensed.

Product imported from the UK and Portugal:

A moulded plastic device containing a blister strip with individual doses of an inhalation powder, pre-dispensed.

6.1 List of excipients

Lactose monohydrate (which contains milk proteins).

6.2 Incompatibilities

6.3 Shelf life

The shelf life expiry date of this product shall be the date shown on the container and outer package of the product on the market in the country of origin.

6.4 Special precautions for storage

Do not store above 30°C.

6.5 Nature and contents of container

The inhalation powder is contained in blisters held on a formed PVC coated base, with a peelable foil laminate lid. The strip is contained in a moulded plastic device. The plastic device is available in a cardboard container, which holds 1 x 60 dose Diskus.

6.6 Special precautions for disposal of a used medicinal product or waste materials derived from such medicinal product and other handling of the product

The Diskus releases a powder which is inhaled into the lungs.
A dose indicator on the Diskus indicates the number of doses left.
